## ACCESS STATEMENT FOR THE BARROW HOUSE

### INTRODUCTION

The Barrow House is located in the centre of the idyllic village of Egerton. We have a selection of local ales, local ciders and a welcoming and cosy bar with log fires in the winter. In the summer our garden looks out over the Weald of Kent. Our menu offers freshly cooked pub food together with more adventurous seasonal dishes served in our Dining Room as well as a roast on Sunday.

There is level access to the pub and a wheelchair accessible WC for our customers.

### PRE-ARRIVAL

- The easiest way to get to us is by car. Please see our website for full details and maps. Our postcode is TN27 9DJ.
- The nearest railway station is Pluckley, with regular trains to Ashford & London. It is 2.1 miles away. If you require an accessible taxi, this will need to be ordered in advance.
- The nearest bus stop is 20m away, the bus service operates between Biddenden and Ashford, Route 123. There are 3 services a day, Monday to Friday only.

### CAR PARKING AND ARRIVAL

- There is free onsite parking for customers. The car park is immediately adjacent to the building. The blue badge parking is available nearest to the disabled entrance.
- The car park surface leads to the disabled ramp with no kerbs.
- The car park is well lit at night.

### BAR & BAR AREA AND DINING AREA/RESTAURANT

- The Bar and Dining Room are situated on the ground floor. The Bar area is all level. There is a small step into the Dining Room.
- Drinks can be served at the table on request.
- There is a mix of seating, banquet seating along the windows, chairs without arms, stools. The tables are all movable and well spaced.
- There is plenty of natural light, augmented with wall lights and spots.

## CUSTOMER TOILETS

- There is a unisex disabled WC. The entrance door is 900mm wide.
- The unisex disabled WC is fitted with standard doc M pack, all handrails.

## BEER GARDEN/OUTDOOR AREA/SMOKING AREA

- Our garden is open all year round. There is a children's play area in the garden.
